

Sam Sheng-Pin Hsu, DDS, MS

Dr. Hsu received his DDS from Taipei Medical University in 1999 and Master of Science in orthodontics from Chang Gung University in 2007. He completed residency in Orthodontics at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital. Then he enrolled a fellowship at the Surgical Planning Laboratory, Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, The Methodist Hospital Research Institute in Houston, Texas, United States. Afterwards, he worked as an assistant professor in department of orthodontics, craniofacial center, Chang Gung Memorial Hospital. Now he manages his private practices in Taipei, Taiwan, where he focuses on the treatment of orthodontics, surgical-orthodontics, and 3D surgical simulation.

Dr. Hsu is a diplomate of Taiwan Board of orthodontics and the Chairman of Orthodontic Promoted Committee of Taiwan Association of Orthodontists (TAO). He was a member of Medical Committee of Association for Dental Sciences of the Republic of China in 2005~2007, and a Director of Taipei Medical University Dental school Alumni Association in 2006~2008. He was also the Deputy Secretary General in 2007~2008, Secretary General in 2009~2010, Chairman of Academic Committee in 2013~2016 of TAO.

Dr. Hsu is a frequent contributor to the literature and has presented in more than 150 national and international conferences in recent 6 years. He also has more than 20 publications in peer reviewed journals.
